Find a path to clean oceans and healthy lands by avoiding some of the activities that harm the environment!



GREENHOUSE GASES

Earth's climate has changed in the past, but today's climate change is different. This is the first time that people's activities are the main cause of the change. Many scientists think we are creating too many **greenhouse gases (GHGs)**, leading to global warming.

GHGs are all around us, in the air and up in the sky. They keep heat from sunlight closer to Earth, warming the planet so that living things can survive. But when there are too many of these gases, they trap too much heat and Earth's temperature rises. This affects the lives of plants, animals and people.
